QUANTITIES

Calculating volumes of mulch is easy. Measure length, width and depth of your area to be mulched and multiply.

Firstly calculate the area to cover ie length \boldsymbol{x} width = square metres, decide the depth of material needed and use the table below to determine the volume required.

SOIL MIXES

GARDEN MIX

Chicken manure, crushed and graded pine bark and mill waste, blended with peat and top soil. This mix is formulated for the vegie garden or general purpose planting. Approximate Ph 7.4.

POTTING MIX

Composted screened pine bark, NPK fertilisers, trace elements and wetting agents. Pine bark is used as it decreases the risk of disease and it has drainage characteristics. PH adjusted to between approximately 5.4 & 6.5.

LAWN MIX

Blended spearwood red loam, yellow sand and manures. Excellent for top dressing lawns.

SOIL CONDITIONER

Chicken manure & sawdust is blended together with peat. Add to existing poor quality soil as an additional source of organics. Designed to mix into existing soil. **DO NOT** plant directly into soil conditioner on its own as it has a strong manure blend & may burn plants.

LANDSCAPE MIX

A black soil mix composed of soil conditioner, yellow sand and loam. Suitable for planting straight into, and specially formulated for native seedlings and tube stock.

MULCHES

MUJA BLACK MULCH

This mulch contains woodwaste and crushed bark and it will retain it's black colour.

KARRI & PEAT MULCH

Crushed jarrah & karri bark, blended with peat. This is a popular mulch for every garden.

KIMBERLEY RED MULCH

This mulch contains crushed pine slithers. It is red in colour & holds its eye catching colour well.

MARRI WOODCHIP

Marri mill waste cut into large chips.

NATURES MULCH

Mulched tree loppings and wood fines. A mulch with a natural presentation.

BUSHLAND MULCH

This black mulch is composed of crushed pine slivers, wood fines, screened black topsoil and manure blended together. It is suitable for all gardens including natives as a feed mulch. Apply to area 60mm thick. Turn once at midseason to allow for even breakdown of mulch. Approximate Ph 7.2.

SAFETY & CARE

Care should be taken when handling these products as irritations or respiratory problems may occur. A group of organisms called legionella is found in these products Use gloves and masks when handling these products.

COLOUR RUN-OFF

Freshly produced mulches may be subject to colour wash-off which can stain driveways, paving bricks etc.

HINTS & TIPS

Mulching is primarily carried out to retain moisture in your garden. This in turn encourages strong and healthy growth in your garden. Your choice of mulch will depend on your needs ie sunny or shaded position, strength of winds and personal preference of colour and texture.

Organic mulches will naturally decompose over time, adding beneficial nutrients to the soil and contributing to garden health. Some mulches will decompose faster than others. For example, course products such as wood chips will take longer to break down than finer mulches.

Mulch should be applied 60-100mm thick. Avoid mulching close to plant stems or tree trunks.
